Response preparedness containment and mitigation of hazardous materials spills is required under numerous regulations, including OSHA, RCRA and the MDEQ.

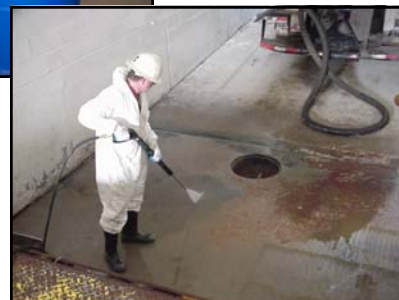
An important part of any spill response or containment program is having the proper spill containment and clean-up materials and equipment available.
